CERTOSA DI PAVIA //////////////

In the morning, after a night spent in Certosa di Pavia right next to a very imposing Franciscan monastery, we

stock up on fresh fruit and regional delicacies, the perfect provisions for the next 400 kilometres to Livorno.



“Moby Lines” offer ferry crossings from Livorno to Sardinia for all budgets. The ferry leaves at 10 PM. If you are planning to go on the water immediately the next morning,

a cabin offers you the best relaxation after a long car journey. To save some money, book a seat or simply bunk down with your air mattress in one of the corridors.



Arriving on the island we immediately realise that the flexible mode of travelling by mobile home is just perfect for us: On Sardinia, one dream spot is right next to the other – from shallow slicks to wave action. All we have to do is follow the wind...

PUNTA TRETTU



In Punta Trettu we are drawn to the beach. Here in the southwest of Sardinia kite conditions in northwesterly and westerly winds are terrific. A headland completely shelters the shore area. Behind it are the perfect shallow water conditions. Everything is ideal here,

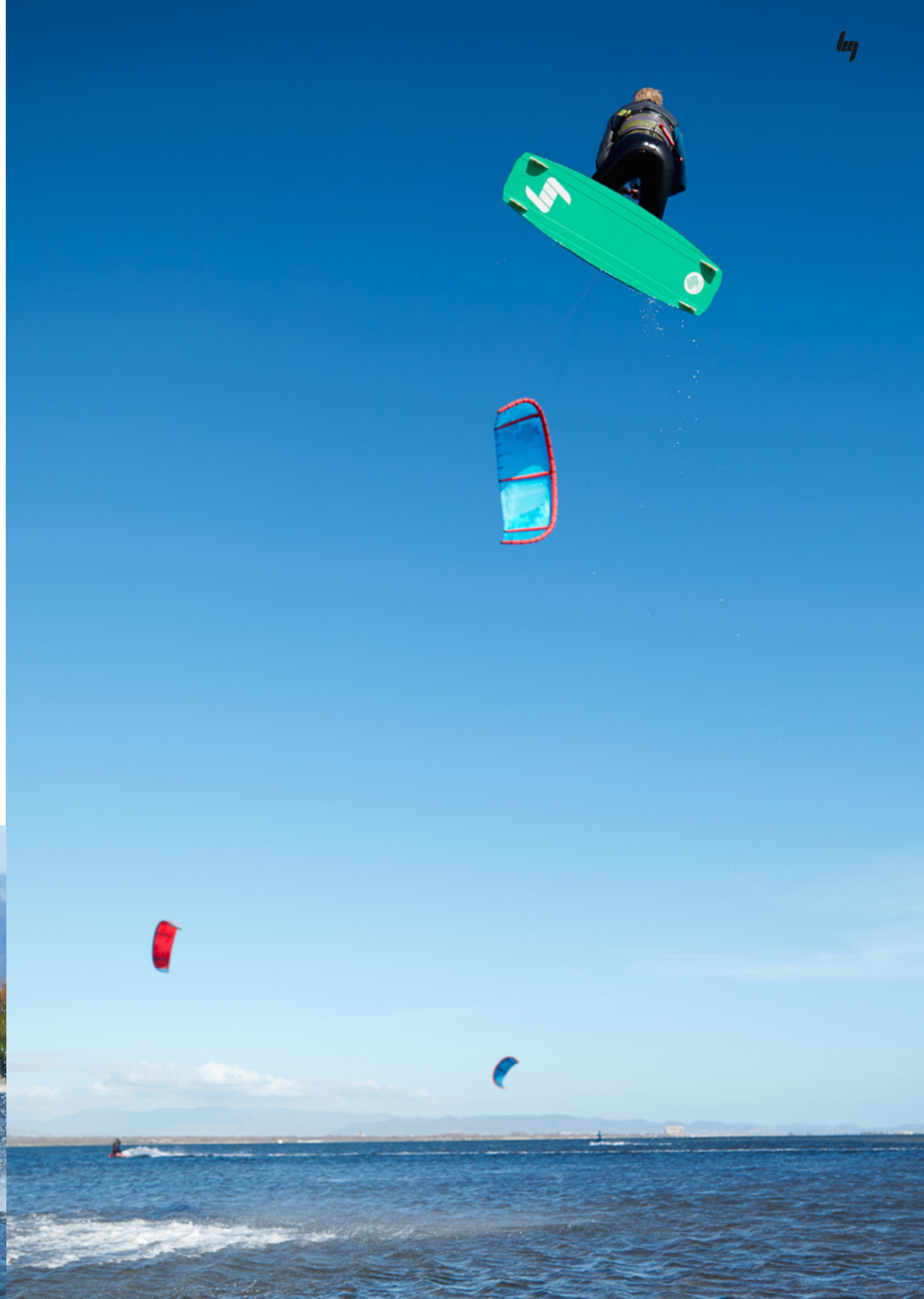
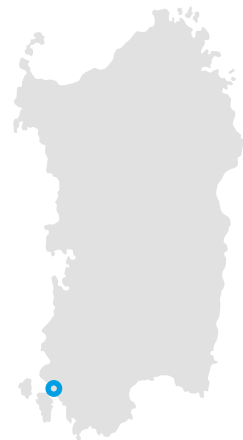
particularly for beginners: The slick area where you can still stand is very large and the wind comes in clean, which makes the spot very safe. In stronger winds, you get swiped off your feet, which makes the location also interesting for experienced riders.



KITEVILLAGE //////////////////////////////////////

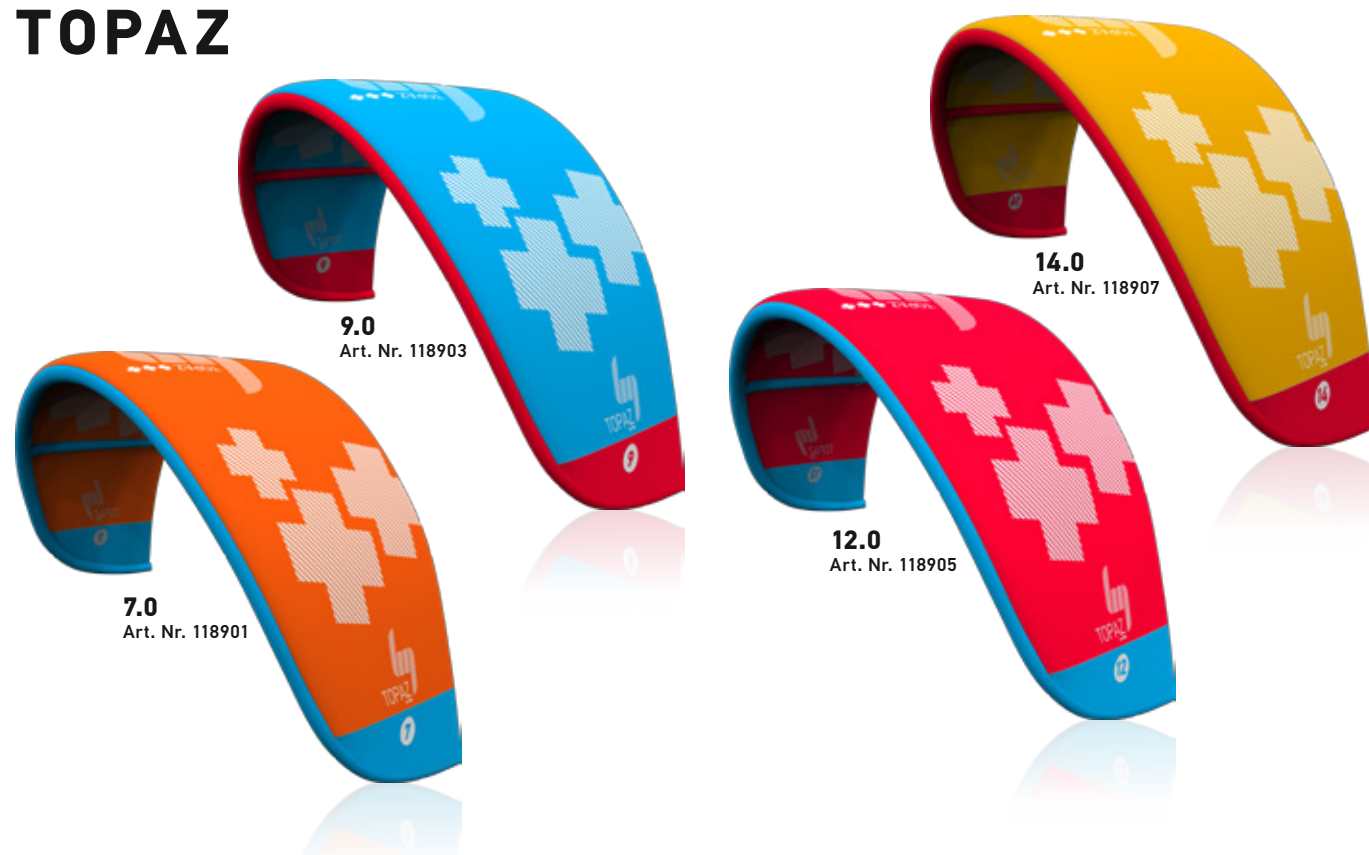


We park our mobile homes in the Kite Village. Its offers spaces for camper vans, a large number of tent sites and rustic, but clean sanitary facilities, all in the middle of a forest. You can buy cool drinks, snacks and small meals at a little bar. If the Kite Village is booked out, go for one of the many parking spaces directly in front of the spot, where overnight camping is also permitted. This is where we meet Laurent and his mates from France. By now we are a group of 15 people, trekking from spot to spot in a seven vehicle convoy.

It is perfectly designed to fly high loops and unhooked moves – without sacrificing a huge wind range or the feeling of comfort. The smaller sizes show their full potential during active flying by delivering massive lift and fast acceleration.

To give you these desirable traits, we have consciously chosen an open C-shaped design with 3 struts, a design that is robust enough to survive even your toughest moves.

Profile and shape pair up to form a perfect symbiosis, creating direct maneuverability with a very good feedback. Robust reinforcements on the leading edge and tips grant your kite a long life, even under extreme conditions.

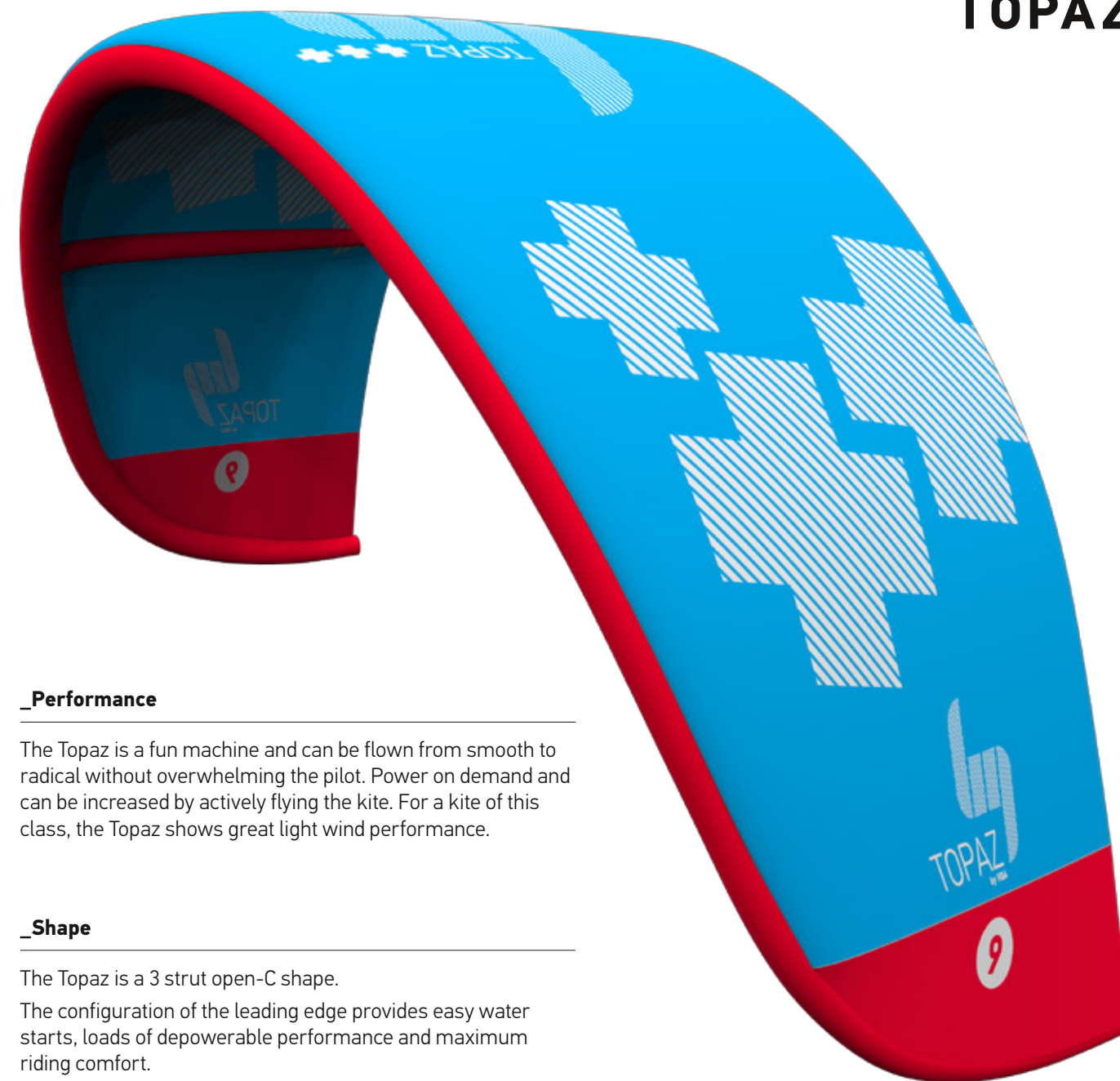

TOPAZ



Performance

The Topaz is a fun machine and can be flown from smooth to radical without overwhelming the pilot. Power on demand and can be increased by actively flying the kite. For a kite of this class, the Topaz shows great light wind performance.

Shape

The Topaz is a 3 strut open-C shape.

The configuration of the leading edge provides easy water starts, loads of depowerable performance and maximum riding comfort.

_Bridle

The bridle of the Topaz was kept short for direct feedback and quick steering. It also reduces possibility of tangling around the wingtip.

_Material

The material mix of the Topaz is designed to withstand incredible forces. The frame of the kite is made of extra strong Dacron to ensure optimal feedback and responsiveness from the kite. Kevlar patches on the leading edge help to protect against chafing and the Tejin sailcloth guarantees color fastness and durability.

_ONE BAR FITS ALL ONE BAR

Our new HQ4 ONE bar is the universal tool for your kite. Besides our tube kites, it can be used with any of our depower kites in our range.

The ONE bar is available in 49 cm and 55 cm and comes with 24 m long stretched dyneema lines and our innovative HQ4 kite leash, that is adjustable in the release strength.

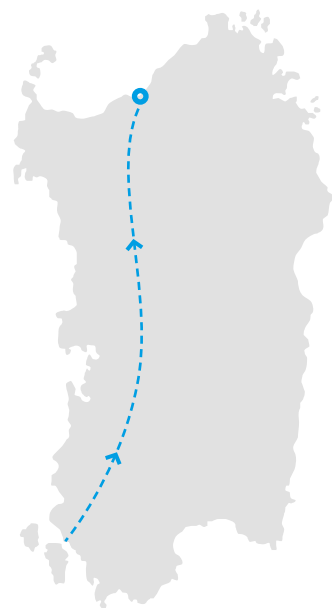
High quality pre-stretched Dyneema lines with almost no elongation for a super direct feel. Sleeved and stitched ends with a maximum load of 300 kg.

bread. While one car drives back the 45 kilometres to get him, the others are already starting to prepare breakfast.



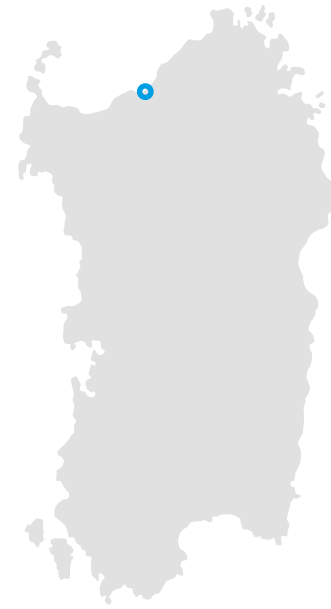
VALLEDORIA

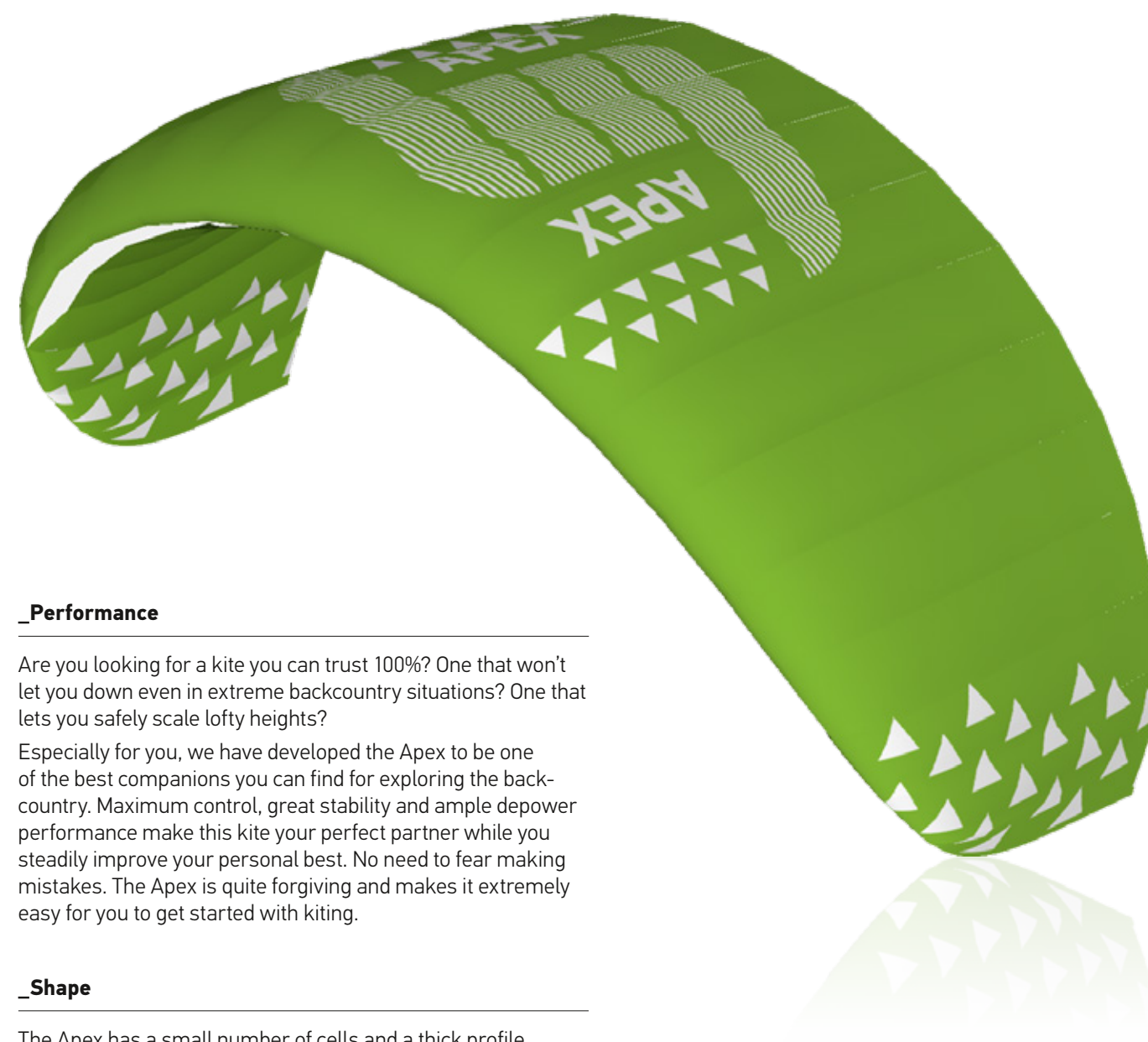

The Apex has a small number of cells and a thick profile. The kite has been specifically designed for flying in difficult wind conditions with maximum stability. The outer cells remain deliberately unleashed to generate better aerodynamics at the wing tips.

_Bridle

The bridle of the Apex is made from robust, sleeved Dyneema, providing long life even in the toughest conditions. Mixer line and pulleys are precisely matched.

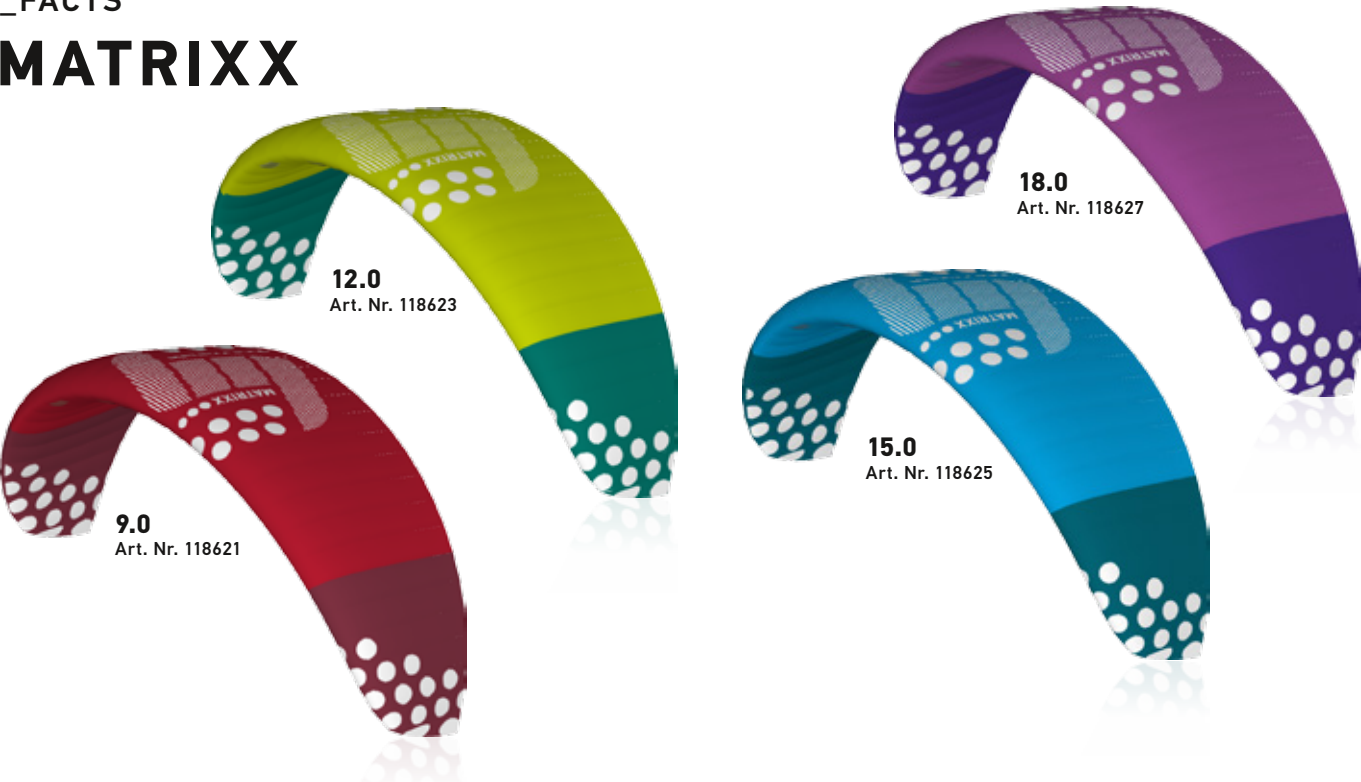
_Material

The sail is made from durable 40D ripstop nylon with a great track record of reliability over the years. The inner cells are reinforced with additional webbing at the air vents.

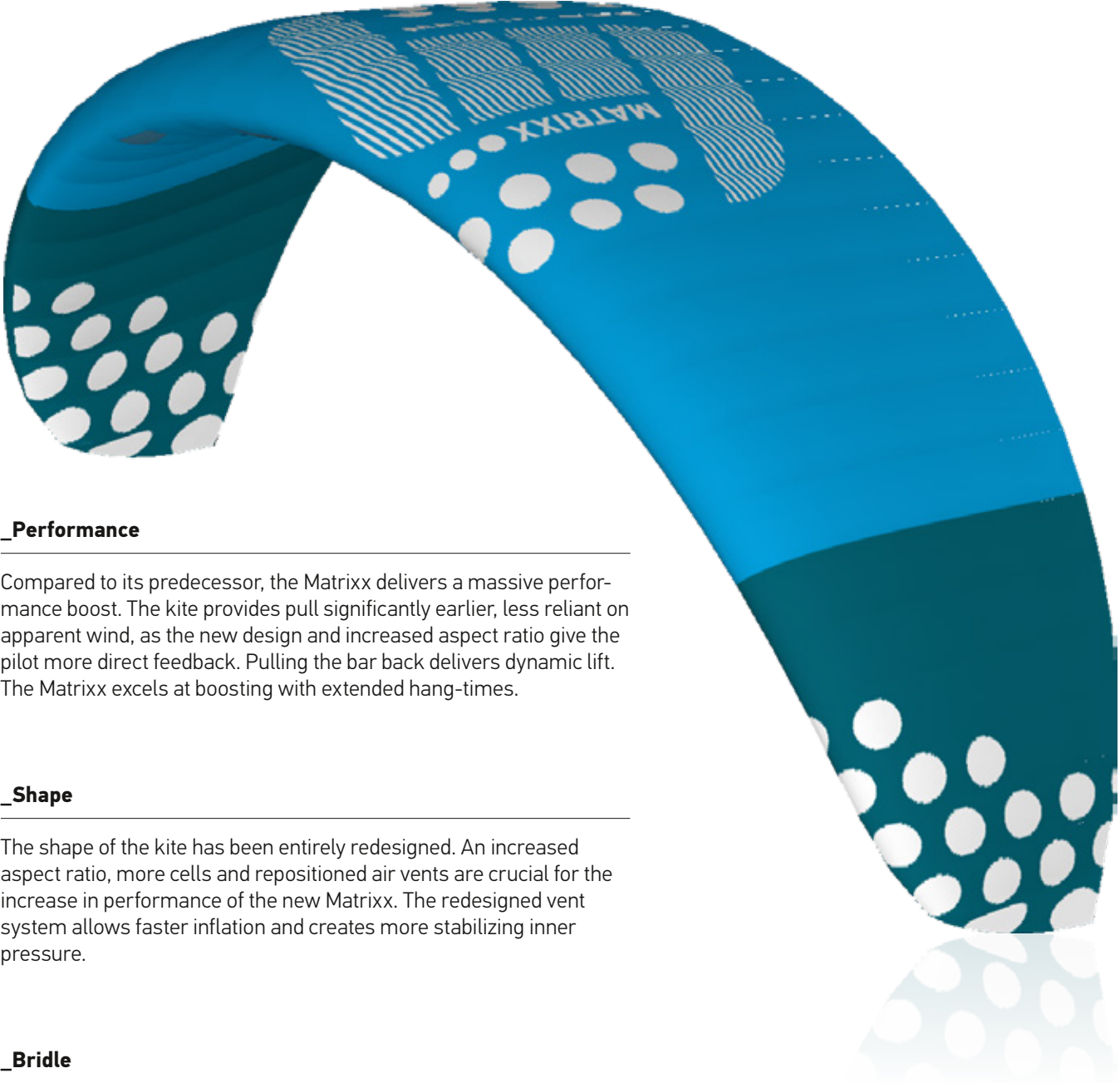

MATRIXX



_Performance

Compared to its predecessor, the Matrixx delivers a massive performance boost. The kite provides pull significantly earlier, less reliant on apparent wind, as the new design and increased aspect ratio give the pilot more direct feedback. Pulling the bar back delivers dynamic lift. The Matrixx excels at boosting with extended hang-times.

_Shape

The shape of the kite has been entirely redesigned. An increased aspect ratio, more cells and repositioned air vents are crucial for the increase in performance of the new Matrixx. The redesigned vent system allows faster inflation and creates more stabilizing inner pressure.

_Bridle

The main bridle of the Matrixx is made from extremely thin, low-stretch and tear-proof Dyneema lines that reduce air resistance to a minimum. The mixer system employs extremely durable Ronstan pulleys and pre-stretched Dyneema lines that require almost no maintenance, even after many hours of flying.

_Material

For the Matrixx sail we use extensively tested high-end sail cloth. The larger sized kites use extremely lightweight 20D ripstop to optimize for light wind flying conditions. The Matrixx 18m weighs only 3.5 kg, including the bar. The smaller sizes are made from our tried and tested 30D cloth.



LA CALETTA //////////

Finally, we meet Fabio Tiboni, owner of the kite school in La Caletta in the northeast of the island. Together with his wife Miriam, he offers everything from yoga on the beach

to kite workshops for experienced riders. Riders can even stay in small apartments in his kite hostel for quite affordable rates.





It is the thermal that makes La Caletta such an interesting spot. And the turquoise blue water with the pearly white sands are simply incredible! By the way, it seems that

Fabio has a good instinct when it comes to wind conditions: Even when the forecast is less positive, he still knows where his guests can go kiting.

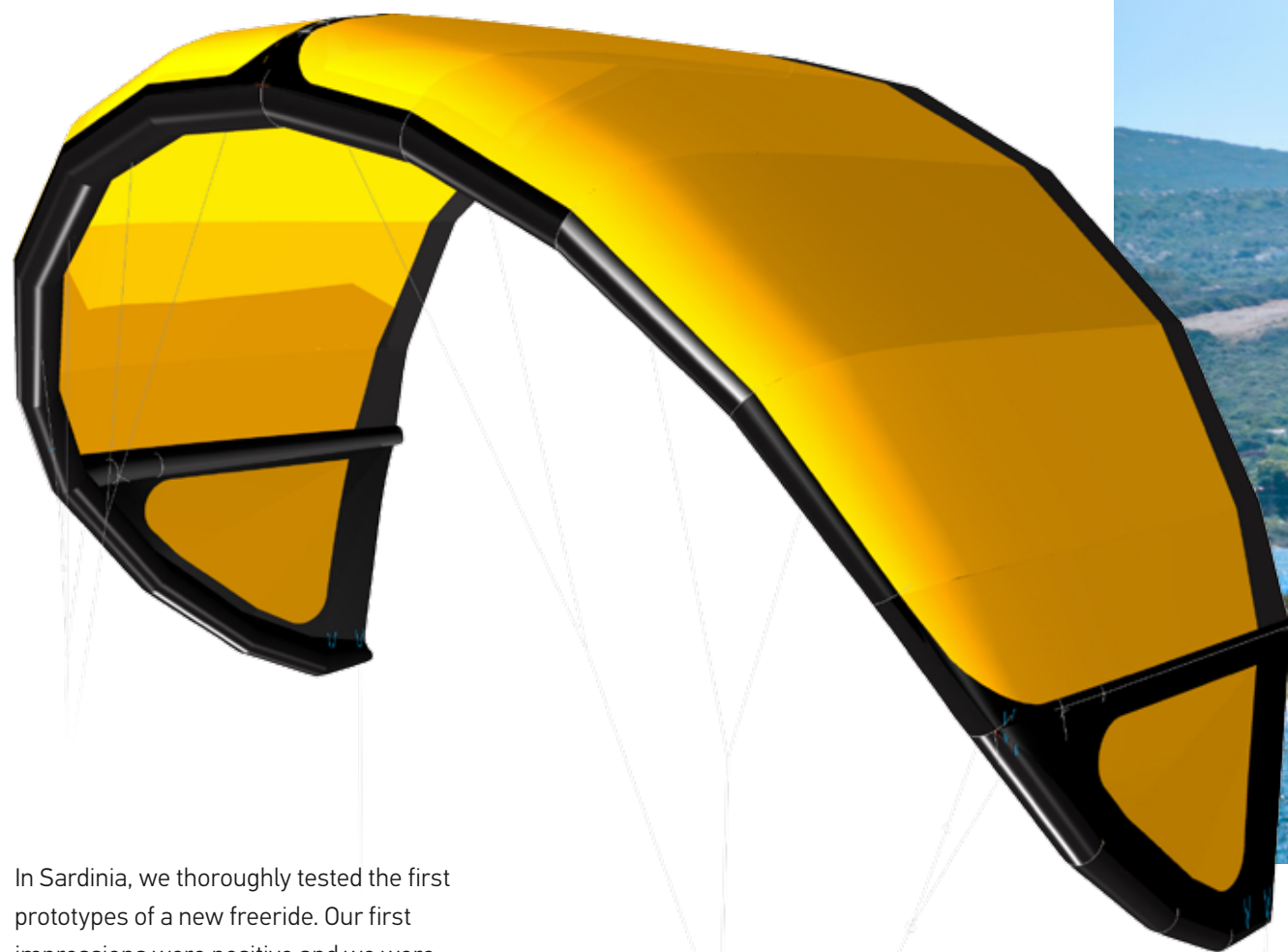

In Sardinia, we thoroughly tested the first prototypes of a new freeride. Our first impressions were positive and we were pleasantly surprised by the amount of power they generated.

Their easy handling was paired with some genes that are normally associated with kites of an entirely different class.

It is obvious right away: Our new tubekite designer Andy Preston did a great job.

Andy has countless years of kite design experience and knows how to scheme to our specific development targets.

We are currently trimming the final five sizes, from 5 m² to 14 m², and are aiming for a spring 2018 release.

And prepare to be amazed about all the other new products and accessories we have in store for you...

"The power delivery is smooth and progressive with great feedback through the bar and the top end wind range is super stable and friendly giving real confidence in the kite. The lower end wind range is also nice with a fast forward flight giving great power delivery from apparent wind.

It has the perfect water launch, not automatic, so it doesn't take you by surprise, but very quick when you need it.

Overall I think this is one of the most friendly kites I've ever designed."
